Cattle Tests 1998-2010 - The numbers of cattle tested and the numbers of cattle slaughtered from 1998 to 2010, broken down on a regional basis.

South West Cattle 1955-2010 - The numbers of cattle existing in South West England in 1955, 1965, 1975, 1985, 1995, 2000 and 2005, taken from available data in the Agriculture Census Survey.
