If you can, please send to me for England for each year from 1998 to 2008 inclusive,

- (a) the number of animals for which there has been a requirement to carry out a bovine tb test,
- (b) the cost of cattle testing,
- (c) the number of animals which were slaughtered, and
- (d) the compensation paid to farmers for these slaughtered animals.

I will then use these figures to calculate for each year the average cost to test each animal by dividing (b) by (a), and the average payment made to farmers for each slaughtered animal by dividing (d) by (c).

I hope this is clear. Obviously please let me know if clarification is required.
